[G] Higher Study Opportunity

Shoolini University helps its students to get higher study opportunity in foreign universities and its faculty members for upgrading their qualifications. International office offers counseling to students aspiring to study in abroad and consultancy for tests such as GRE, IELTS and TOEFL. Foreign Universities have several scholarships available for international students. There are scholarships that are funded by the foreign government and by foreign university itself. Because of the variety of scholarships on offer, the eligibility criteria for each of them are different. Till date 5 Shoolini students have got annual scholarship 15-18 lakh rupees, which covers tuition fee

and living expenses in abroad. Further, 3 faculty members have availed postdoc opportunity from foreign universities.
