Senior Research Fellow (Two positions)

Qualification:

M. Pharmacy with minimum 60% marks or Equivalent grade or M.Sc. (Botany/Chemistry) from a recognized university with 2 years’ research experience in handling work relating to natural products/medicinal plants. GATE/GPAT/CSIR-NET or equivalent examination qualified candidates will be preferred.

- (i) Experience in plant taxonomy, pharmacognostic characterization, phytochemical studies, standardization of medicinal plants, preparation of monographs, literature search, retrieval, scientific writing, dissemination of information relating to medicinal plants
- (ii) Diploma/Degree in computer applications
