Subject: **Regarding reservation for Economically Weaker Sections (EWSs) for admissions in Higher Education Institutions.**

Sir,

In continuation to this deptt. letter of even No. dated 12<sup>th</sup> August, 2021 whereby instructions dated 20-08-2020 issued by this deptt. regarding reservation to Economic Weaker Section (EWSs) in admission has been withdrawn in view of various representation received qua sports/ cultural quota etc.

The issue was examined again at length and it has been observed that:-

1. Additional Chief Secretary (Personnel) to the Govt. of HP vide his office letter No. PER (AP)-C-B(12)-1/2019 dated 13<sup>th</sup> June, 2019 (copy enclosed) had informed that the Council of Ministers had approved on 11-06-2019 to provide 10% reservation to the Economically Weaker Sections (EWSs) in admission to Higher Educational Institutions from the academic year 2019-20.

2. Detailed procedure/guidelines have been prescribed under clause 3.1 of 1<sup>st</sup> Ordinance of Himachal Pradesh University, 1973 (Volume-1) whereby reservations have been provided for SC/ST & sports/Cultural quota for admission to the Higher Educational Institutions.
3. As per notification no 4-16/1999-HPU (Acad.) P & D- Vol.III dated 3<sup>rd</sup> October, 2017 issued by Registrar Himachal Pradesh University in furtherance to Hon. High Court Judgment CWPII No 103 of 2017 dated 13<sup>th</sup> October, 2017 provision for 5% reservation to students with special needs has been provided by the H.P. University.
4. Ministry of Human Resource Development deptt. of Higher Education vide its Letter No. -F No: 12-4/2019-U1 dated 17<sup>th</sup> January, 2019 has prescribed that  
*"In accordance with the provisions of the Constitution (One Hundred and Third Amendment) Act 2019, and the reference of Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment vide OM No. 20013/01/2018-BC-II dated 17<sup>th</sup> January, 2019, enabling provision of reservation for the Economically Weaker Sections (EWSs) who are not covered under the existing scheme of reservations for the Scheduled Castes, it has been decided to provide reservation in admission to educational institutions subject to a maximum of ten per cent of the total seats in each category. This would not apply to the minority educational institutions referred to in clause (1) of Article 30 of the Constitution of India.*



*The provision of reservations to the Economically Weaker Sections shall be in accordance with the directions contained in the OM No. 20013/01/2018-BC-II dated 17<sup>th</sup> January, 2019 of the Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment.*

The UGC had also endorsed the above referred communication of Ministry of Human Resource Development dated 17-01-2019 to all concerned vide its letter No. F. No. 81-1/2019 (CU) dated 18<sup>th</sup> January, 2019 (Copy enclosed).

5. The office Memorandum F. No 20013/01/2018-BC-II dated 17<sup>th</sup> January, 2019 issued by Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment (copy enclosed) provides that

*"In pursuance of insertion of clauses 15(6) and 16 (6) in the Constitution vide the Constitution (One Hundred and Third Amendment) Act, 2019 and in order to enable the Economically weaker Sections (EWSs) who are not covered under the existing scheme of reservations for the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes and the Socially and Educationally Backward Classes, to receive the benefits of reservation on a preferential basis in civil posts and services in the Government of India and admission in Educational Institutions, it has been decided by the Government to provide 10% reservations to EWSs in civil posts and services in Government of India and admission in Educational Institutions.*

Since the issue of reservations in admissions to Higher Educational Institutions is to be addressed as per Clause 3.1 of 1<sup>st</sup> Ordinance of Himachal Pradesh University, 1973 (Volume-1) therefore the instructions issued by Deptt. of Personnel are required to be implemented by the H.P. University, while keeping in view the reservation already provided to various categories in Higher Educational Institutions

You are therefore requested to implement the decision of the State Govt. dated 13<sup>th</sup> June, 2019 in letter and spirit & provide for reservation to EWSs in admissions as approved along with reservation already available to SC/ST /Sports/Cultural & other categories.

Subject:- Reservation for Economically Weaker Sections (EWSs) in civil posts and services in the State Government and admission in Educational Institutions.

Sir,

I am directed to say that the matter regarding providing of 10% reservation to the Economically Weaker Sections (EWSs) in the services of the State was placed before the Council of Ministers' meeting held on 01.06.2019 and same was approved by the Council of Ministers. The instructions to this effect stand issued by the State Government vide Department of Personnel's letter No.PER(AP)-C-B(12)-1/2019, dated 11.06.2019. The following point, as point No.3 of the point for consideration, has also been placed before the Council of Ministers' for its consideration which has also been approved by the CMM (copy enclosed):-

"Whether 10% reservation to the Economically Weaker Sections (EWSs) in admission to higher educational institutions may be provided which would become operational from the academic year 2019-20? However, modalities/detailed instructions regarding operation of roster and procedure for implementation of EWS reservation in higher educational institutions will be finalized by the respective Administrative Departments under whom such higher educational institutions are running."

2. You are, therefore, requested to take necessary action with regard to implementation of reservation for Economically Weaker Sections (EWSs) for admission in educational institutions being Administrative Department.

3. The persons who are not covered under the scheme of reservation for SCs, STs and OBCs and whose family has gross annual income below Rs.4.00 Lakh (Rupees four lakh only) are to be identified as Economically Weaker Sections (EWSs) for benefit of reservation. Also persons whose family owns or possesses any of the following assets shall be excluded from being identified as EWS, irrespective of the family income:-

- i. More than 1 hectare of Agricultural Land in rural areas and 500 M<sup>2</sup> land in urban areas;
- ii. Residential flat/house of more than 2500 square feet in rural/urban areas.
- iii. Family of income tax payee;
- iv. Family of Regular/Contract employees of the Central Government, State Government, Board, Corporations and autonomous bodies and Public Sector Undertakings etc.;

4. The candidates belonging to unreserved B.P.L. category shall also be treated as eligible for EWS reservation on the basis of valid B.P.L. certificate issued by competent authority and countersigned by the Block Development Officer and supplemented by the non-SC/ST/OBC certificate issued by the competent authority.

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## CHAPTER III

## ADMISSION

**3.1. Admission and reservation (1):** Admissions to the various courses of study except MBBS, M.D., M.S., Diploma Courses in Medical Science, M.C.A. and D.C.A. shall be open to all persons, irrespective of race, creed, caste or class subject to the following conditions:-


- (a) 15% and 7 1/2% of the seats shall be reserved for Schedule Castes and Schedule Tribes candidates respectively who have passed their qualifying examination from Himachal Pradesh University or H.P. Krishi Vishvavidyalaya or Dr. Y.S. Parmar University of Horticulture and Forestry.
- (b) The remaining 77 1/2% seats shall be filled as under:-
  - i) 25% of the seats for admission shall be open for all the candidates irrespective of the Institution from where they have passed their qualifying examination;
  - ii) 75% of the seats shall be filled out of the candidates who have passed their qualifying examination from Himachal Pradesh University or H.P. Krishi Vishvavidyalaya or Dr. Y.S. Parmar University of Horticulture and Forestry, subject to the following reservations:
    - (a) 5% of the seats shall be reserved for outstanding sportsmen/women.
    - (b) 5% of the seats shall be reserved for outstanding cultural activists.
    - (c) 3% of the seats shall be reserved for Physically handicapped candidates.
- (2) The minimum qualifications for admission to a course in case of candidates belonging to scheduled castes & scheduled tribes categories shall be relaxed by 5% of the maximum marks. The admission to these reserved seats as stated at (a), (b) & (c) to para (ii) of clause (b) above shall be made as per procedure/rules approved by the Executive Council from time to time.
- (3) The candidates seeking admission to M.B.A. course, having



In accordance with the provisions of the Constitution (One Hundred and Third Amendment) Act 2019, and the reference of Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment vide OM No. 20013/01/2018-BC-II dated 17th January 2019, enabling provision of reservation for the Economically Weaker Sections (EWSs) who are not covered under the existing scheme of reservations for the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes and the Socially and Educationally Backward Classes, it has been decided to provide reservation in admission to educational institutions subject to a maximum of ten per cent of the total seats in each category. This would not apply to the minority educational institutions referred to in clause (1) of Article 30 of the Constitution of India.

2. The provision of reservations to the Economically Weaker Sections shall be in accordance with the directions contained in the OM No. 20013/01/2018-BC-II dated 17th January 2019 of the Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment and shall be subject to the following:

- a) The reservations shall be provided to EWSs for admission in Central Educational Institutions, (as defined in clause (d) of section (2) of The Central Educational Institutions (Reservation in Admission) Act, 2006) from the academic year 2019-20 onwards.
- b) The above reservation would not be applicable to the 8 institutions of excellence, research institutions, institutions of national & strategic importance as specified in the Schedule to The Central Educational Institutions (Reservation in Admission) Act, 2006, as amended from time to time, and appended to this OM, and to the minority educational institutions referred to in clause (1) of article 30 of the Constitution.
- c) Every Central Educational Institution shall, with the prior approval of the appropriate authority (as defined in clause (c) of section 2 of The Central Educational Institutions (Reservation in Admission) Act, 2006), increase the number of seats over and above its annual permitted strength in each branch of


study or faculty so that the number of seats available, excluding those reserved for the persons belonging to the EWSs, is not less than the number of such seats available, in each category, for the academic session immediately preceding the date of the coming into force of this O.M.

- d) Where, on a representation by any Central Educational Institution, the appropriate authority is satisfied that for reasons of financial, physical or academic limitations or in order to maintain the standards of education, the annual permitted strength in any branch of study or faculty of such institution cannot be increased for the academic session following the commencement of this Act, it may permit such institution to increase the annual permitted strength over a maximum period of two years beginning with the academic session following the commencement of this Act; and then, the extent of reservation for the Economically Weaker Sections shall be limited for that academic session in such manner that the number of seats made available to the Economically Weaker Sections for each academic session shall not reduce the number and the percentage of reservations provided for SC/ST/OBC categories.
- e) The scheme for implementing the reservation for the EWS shall be displayed on the website of the institution as soon as possible, but no later than 31st March 2019.

3. The Chairman UGC, Chairman AICTE and Chairperson NCTE and the Bureau Heads of the Department of Higher Education in the Ministry of Human Resource Development responsible for management of the Institutions of National Importance are requested to ensure immediate compliance of this OM.

4. This issues with the approval of the Minister for Human Resource Development.

In pursuance of insertion of clauses 15(6) and 16(6) in the Constitution vide the Constitution (One Hundred and Third Amendment) Act, 2019 and in order to enable the Economically Weaker Sections (EWSs) who are not covered under the existing scheme of reservations for the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes and the Socially and Educationally Backward Classes, to receive the benefits of reservation on a preferential basis in civil posts and services in the Government of India and admission in Educational Institutions, it has been decided by the Government to provide 10% reservation to EWSs in civil posts and services in Government of India and admission in Educational Institutions.

2. Persons who are not covered under the existing scheme of reservations for the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes and the Socially and Educationally Backward Classes and whose family has gross annual income below Rs. 8.00 lakh are to be identified as EWSs for the benefit of reservation. Family for this purpose will include the person who seeks benefit of reservation, his/her parents and siblings below the age of 18 years as also his/her spouse and children below the age of 18 years. The income shall include income from all sources i.e. salary, agriculture, business, profession etc. and it will be income for the financial year prior to the year of application. Also persons whose family owns or possesses any of the following assets shall be excluded from being identified as EWSs, irrespective of the family income:

- i. 5 acres of Agricultural Land and above;
- ii. Residential flat of 1000 sq. ft. and above;
- iii. Residential plot of 100 sq. yards and above in notified municipalities;

iv. Residential plot of 200 sq. yards and above in areas other than the notified municipalities.

3. The income and assets of the families as mentioned in para 2 would be required to be certified by an officer not below the rank of Tehsildar in the States/UTs. The officer who issues the certificate would do the same after carefully verifying all relevant documents following due process as prescribed by the respective State/ UT.

4. Every Educational Institution shall, with the prior approval of the appropriate authority, increase the number of seats over and above its annual permitted strength in each branch of study or faculty so that the number of seats available, excluding those reserved for the persons belonging to the EWSs, are not less than the total seats available in the academic session immediately preceding the date of the coming into force of this O.M.

5. Instructions regarding reservation in employment and admission to educational institutions will be issued by DoPT and Ministry of HRD respectively.

Sir,

I am directed to say that pursuant to coming into force "The Constitution (One Hundred and Third Amendment) Act, 2019" with effect from 14<sup>th</sup> January, 2019 subsequently issuing of guidelines in this regard by the Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment Government of India and Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment Government of India and Ministry of Personnel, Public Grievances and Pensions, Department of Personnel and Training, Government of India, the matter regarding implementation of Constitution (one Hundred and Third Amendment) Act, 2019 and in compliance of orders passed by the Hon'ble High Court in **CWPIL No.103 of 2017 titled as Court on its own Motion versus State of H.P.** and others dated 05-09-2017 to implement the section 32 of the Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016, circulated by the Government of India vide their later dated 19-04-2017 under which the percentage of

reservation of seats for the purpose of seeking admission for disabled students has been extended from 3% to 5% were under active consideration at Govt. level. It has been decided with the prior approval of competent authority that as a result of this decision of the State Government, it is hereby notified that **10%** reservation would be provided for Economically Weaker Sections and **5%** reservation would be provided for Persons With Disabilities (PWDs) in Educational Institutions for the purpose of admission in various courses on or after issuance of these instructions. The benefit of reservation under Economic Weaker Section (EWS) and Person with Disability (PWDs) can be given as per the reservation roster given at **Annexure-A** and **Annexure-B**.
