Medical Facilities

Health/Medical Centre at Shoolini University

Shoolini University prioritizes the well-being of its community and provides comprehensive medical facilities for students and staff. The university's Health Centre is well-equipped to cater to various medical needs. Dr. Lavish, a qualified (MBBS) medical doctor, along with a dedicated team comprising three resident staff nurses, pharmacist, and lab technician, ensures seamless healthcare services. The center features a medical consultation room, dispensary, dressing room, and a pathology lab. Additionally, beds are equipped with oxygen cylinders and concentrators to handle emergencies effectively.

An ambulance is available on campus, with 24x7 ambulance services accessible to students and staff. Regular health camps and check-ups are organized for faculty and staff, with doctors from reputed hospitals conducting medical and dental examinations. Generic medicines are readily available within the campus, including at the Health Centre, in hostels, and in the gym. These initiatives reflect the university's commitment to ensuring the health and safety of its employees and students.
