AQAR (Annual Quality Assurance Report for the year 2016 -17)

Chairman discussed the format of AQAR with the committee members and informed all present that AQAR timely filing are minimum institutional requirement for NAAC's subsequent accreditation and shall be taken very seriously, Ms. Patil was given the responsibility to file the same by January ending.

National Institutional Ranking Framework

Chairman further informed the committee that this Year University has participated in Overall, Pharmacy and Management discipline and also shared the importance given to these rankings in India.

He further explained with a presentation that NIRF provide a wonderful framework for quality assurance in the university. The five parameters used for rankings are - Teaching Learning and Resources (TLR) having 30% weightage, Research and Professional Practice (RPP) having 30% weightage, Graduation outcomes (GO) having 20% weightage, Outreach Inclusivity having 10 % weightage and Perception having 10% weightage. Discussions continued on the methodology used and following initiatives were decided:

➤ Efforts by Director Research for promoting research culture in the campus and accelerating research grants

> Patents filing to be improved

Encouraging in-house faculty members to pursue Ph.D.

> Publications to be increased in good journals

The members desired that above points be looked into in phased manner to improve rankings of Shoolini University.
